

2023 (The 17th) Japan International Award for Young Agricultural Researchers (Japan Award)

1 Outline of the Award

(1) Purpose

The purpose of this annual award is to motivate young researchers who engage in research and development in agriculture, forestry, fisheries and related industries in developing regions. The chairman of the Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries Research Council (AFFRC) bestows testimonials on up to three young researchers who have shown outstanding performance and research achievements.

(2) Candidates

Candidates should be researchers who are nationals of developing countries and/or territories, under 40 years of age as of 1 January 2023, belong to a non-Japanese research institute or a non-Japanese university, and are engaged in research and development in agriculture, forestry, fisheries and related industries in developing regions.

(3) Award

The awardees will be invited to Japan to attend the awarding ceremony. The chairman of the AFFRC bestows testimonials on the winners. They also win “MOTAI-JIRCAS Award*” of USD5,000 per capita.

*Mr. Shigeru MOTAI is the former Chairman of the AFFRC and the donor of this award.
